

ARCCC Elections A CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

ARCCC survives and thrives because of the volunteer efforts of its members. Serving on the Executive Committee is a vital task which requires creativity, commitment, energy and the ability to work with a team of like-minded professionals. It is also highly rewarding.

Each year, at its Annual General Meeting, ARCCC holds elections to fill required posts. This year's election will be held Friday, May 4, at the joint ARCCC/CCP conference in Hamilton. All Organizational and Individual paid-up members of ARCCC are eligible to vote and to hold office.

This year, there are several posts requiring an election:

1. President: Pam Aleman has finished her first two-year term and has offered to stand for a second term.

- 2. Vice-president Western Region: Currently vacant.
- 3. Vice-president Eastern Region: Aurea Sadi is eligible for a second term and has offered to let her name stand. There will also be two posts that were filled during the year through Executive appointment.

These will require ratification by the general membership:

- 1. Communications Chair and Vice-President, Central Region: Emilie Callan.
- 2. Membership Chair: Winetta Nguyen

As chair of the Election subcommittee, I will conduct the proceedings. I also call for nominations to those posts for which elections will be held.
